

## 100 Years

Today marks significant date in the history of our West Allotment Memorial.

It is 100 years since the memorial was first erected and dedicated, to mark that event our Vicar, The Rev Rae Caro will do us the honour of rededicating the memorial.

The memorial was erected in 1925, paid by public subscription. Local people raised the £400 for the memorial, raffles and even football matches to reach almost the entire sum, a generous local benefactor made up the rest.

The Angel was the result of a competition in schools to submit a design, a prize of £10 being offered.

Records seem to indicate that the young lad who submitted the winning design never actually received the prize. The angel is holding a flag in her left arm and a laurel wreath in her right.

The date on the memorial is 1914 to 1919. An armistice had been signed in 1918, the war itself did not end until 1919
